### Single Student Data Entry

Select text level from drop down menu.

↓ Data point code where the 1<sup>st</sup> number indicates the grade level, the 2<sup>nd</sup> the data point.

↓ Drop down menu to select text level for the given data point.

Start data point selected. Start 0.5

End data point selected. End 1.6

Select start data point.

Select end data point.

Set a start & end point for analysis in order to project future growth. This is often the first and last data point with data entered.  
Older browsers: If unable to select start & end points with the slider that should appear above use [alternate data entry page](#).

If you'd like to have a 2 letter code placed on the RAPID Chart enter that here. You may also leave it blank and no code will appear.

After all data is entered, click button to create a RAPID Chart.
