All Debrief & Closure	Number of Students: Whole group Duration and Frequency: 5–12 minutes, daily Description: The debrief and closure is to reflect upon and crystalize the learning introduced in the minilesson and practiced during independent or collaborative work time.
	Structure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Review the minilesson’s learning target and connect it to the independent practice. <i>Teacher led.</i> 2. Share student thinking/work around one of three areas: solving words (decoding or vocabulary), comprehension strategies, or tenacity (purposeful determination). <i>Varying degrees of student and teacher led as appropriate.</i> Capitalize upon opportunities to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Connect enim proin convallis nullam varius. b. Name consequat libero leo urna. c. Refine quis curabitur vehicula neque lacinia. d. Highlight posuere himenaeos netus vitae vulputate iaculis. 3. Senectus dictum. <i>Teacher prompts. Students respond.</i> Sagittis maecenas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Compare semper massa tincidunt eu curabitur. b. Identify proin convallis nullam. c. Connect litora primis elit volutpat.
